HumanWare provides assistive technology to people who are blind or have low vision. They have released the **BrailleNote Touch**; the first Google-certified, Android-based Braille tablet. With a 32 cell refreshable Braille display and a touch screen, this device provides speech and Braille output to the user.

- Keysoft is the special software that provides the speech and Braille output.
- Since it is an Android-based tablet, users can download and run mainstream apps, as long as the apps are accessible to them.
- Activities include Shared Reading, Shared Writing, and Infusion Activities to incorporate within daily routines. Contains Home Extension Activities to support skill carryover and generalization.
- Beginner and advanced Braille readers can benefit from this tool. Braille keyboard or through a method called touch Braille.

- Students can type out math in Braille and share their work with the teacher on their desired platform.
